he Northwest boasts a wealth of accommodation styles: enormous high-rise hotels, multi-unit motor inns and large luxury resorts. But if you are looking for something a bit more intimate, book a room at one of the following six spectacular boutique lodgings. To qualify as "boutique," it must offer fewer than 100 guest rooms. Each one that made our list offers far fewer, ensuring a personal touch in a relaxed environment with well-appointed amenities, delicious dining onsite or nearby and an air of distinction.

Ravenscroft Inn, Port Townsend, WA

Ravenscroft Inn offers eight charming and well-appointed guest rooms, each with a view of Port Townsend Bay, Mount Rainier or Mount Baker. The colonial-style house with its distinctive Southern architecture (not typically found in the Northwest) looks like it could have been transported from Charleston, South Carolina. The Inn features exceptional amenities and gracious hospitality. Relax with a book in the library, cozy up by the fire in the great room or breathe in the fresh sea air while sitting on the veranda.

Hidden in a quiet residential neighborhood within walking distance of downtown and the bay, explore the town's delicious restaurants, booming art scene and boutique shops. Visit the local bakery and explore the Saturday Market.

Rooms at the Inn are warm and inviting. The Bay and Baker rooms flaunt stunning sunrises and sunsets, and all rooms include a private bathroom and high-speed internet. The beds, dressed in uncommonly soft silky sheets and astonishingly fluffy pillows, ensure a restful night's sleep.
